- ◆ **Basic Computing for Adults**—For adults who may want to keep in touch with their whanau/families, or learn some basic computer skills such as on-line banking, face book, or trademe.
Those who need to upskill for work, basic word or excel skills.
- ◆ **Transition to School (*parent and child*)**—For families to learn together, activities that support their child's developing literacy and mathematics skills as they make the transition to school.
- ◆ **Engaging Priority Families in Early Childhood Education**—Supports families to engage with their nearest Early Childhood service.

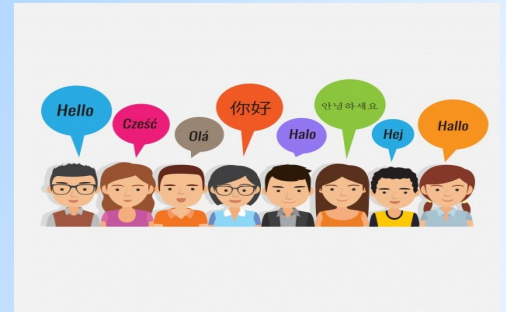
